## Emergency Shelter / Self-Refer / No Fees

**Men's Drop-In Shelter** | Porchlight, Inc. | 116 W Washington Ave, Madison, WI 53703

**Description:** Located in the lower levels of Grace Episcopal Church on the Capitol Square. Entrance through the central courtyard. Night shelter only. 60-night limit for the shelter year from Nov 1 – Oct 31. Weather exceptions for all nights below 20° w/wind chill or during other inclement weather; extensions granted on a case-by-case basis as a bridge to housing or employment.

**Summer:** 7:30PM – 7:00AM, **Intake:** 7:30PM-10:00PM; **Winter:** 5:00PM – 7:30AM, **Intake:** 5:00PM – 9:00PM

**Services Include:** Dinner, breakfast, personal grooming supplies, laundry, & counseling services

**Description:** Daytime emergency shelter services for single adults living w/documentated mental illness. Safe Haven clients may be entered onto the waiting list for Safe Haven temporary housing.

**Services Include:**

Permanent one-bedroom units for men and women in recovery from alcohol and drug abuse (90 days of sobriety required). Case management services are provided and may include money management, personal health, relapse prevention, parenting, assistance with permanent housing and employment counseling. **Rents start at \$500 per month.** Programs vary based on length of sobriety.
